

## ANNEX II

### SWITZERLAND'S CONCESSIONS TO KOREA ON BASIC AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Switzerland shall reduce or eliminate customs duties on goods originating in Korea as indicated for each tariff heading in the following table. Where the concession is listed in column 3, Switzerland shall not apply a higher customs duty than that specified in that column. Where the concession is listed in column 4, Switzerland shall reduce the customs duty applicable at the time of importation by the amount specified in that column.
